## **Districtwide Achievements**

♦ T/E students consistently perform among the top five percent of all public schools on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment, which is administered in reading, math, writing and science to every third, fifth, eighth and eleventh grade student in Pennsylvania public schools. The average scaled scores for T/E students were among the very highest in the State. Detailed test results are available at <u>www.tesd.net/testing</u>.

♦ T/E students at all levels demonstrated outstanding performance in numerous science and math competitions throughout the school year including a State championship in the Pennsylvania Math League contest; scores in the top 1% of the nation in the American Mathematics Competition; high placements in local science fair competitions; participation in a STEM Design Challenge; and a student-organized TED Talks program.

 The Conestoga Class of 2014 was a leader in Pennsylvania with twenty-six National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists, forty-five National Merit Commended Students, three National Achievement Scholars and two National Achievement Scholars.

◆ 95% of Conestoga's Class of 2014 chose to attend college after high school. Conestoga students consistently scored well above State and national averages on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) which is a standardized college entrance exam. Conestoga students ranked second in Pennsylvania on SAT scores.

 In 2013, Conestoga High School students completed 1,599 Advanced Placement tests. The average score was 4.08 on a 5 point scale.

• Conestoga High School's team placed first in the Pennsylvania Economics Challenge.

 Three Conestoga High School students were selected for State Orchestra and Choir. These students advanced to the State competition after successfully qualifying for district then regional competitions.

✤ T/E School District middle school and high school student athletes have been recognized for exhibiting outstanding sportsmanship and for capturing numerous regional titles.
