

T/E School District 2011-2012 School Year Highlights

- ◆ T/E students consistently perform among the top five percent of all public schools on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment, which is administered in reading, math, writing and science to every third, fifth, eighth and eleventh grader in Pennsylvania public schools. The average scaled scores for T/E students were among the very highest in the State in 2011.
- ◆ The Conestoga Class of 2012 led Pennsylvania schools with twenty-six National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists, twenty-four National Merit Commended Students, one National Achievement Scholar and five National Hispanic Scholars.
- ◆ T/E School District was selected to the “AP District Achievement Honor Roll” for 2011. The AP District Achievement Honor Roll nationally recognizes and acknowledges the District’s success and efforts to expand AP access and performance as well as commitment to increasing student achievement. Only 388 districts were selected nationwide.
- ◆ Of Conestoga High School’s 520 graduates, ninety-five percent chose to attend college after high school. Conestoga students consistently scored well above state and national averages on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) which is a standardized college entrance exam.
- ◆ Students in third through eighth grades participate in a digital citizenship curriculum to learn about online safety, cyber bullying, online privacy, social network responsibility and the future effects of a personal “digital footprint.”
- ◆ A research-based program to promote a positive school climate is in place at the elementary and middle schools as the foundation of a safe learning environment. At the high school level, peer mediators support fellow students through conflict resolution, anger management, tolerance and school-wide unity events in the Conestoga community.
- ◆ T/E School District middle school and high school student athletes have been recognized for exhibiting outstanding sportsmanship and for capturing numerous state titles.
- ◆ Conestoga High School ranked high among high schools nationally in numerous commercial publications including *U.S. News and World Report*, *Newsweek* and *The Washington Post*.
- ◆ Districtwide efforts to conserve resources by going “green” include paperless communication, online grade access, reduced energy consumption and recycling. The T/E School District also received a grant for the use of clean fuels in transportation.

Complimentary Admission to Events for Senior Citizens and Veterans

T/E School District community members who are veterans or who are age 62 or older can attend most School District activities and events without charge. A Complimentary Admission to Events Pass is available to senior citizens and veterans, free of charge, from the receptionist at the T/E School District Administration Offices at 940 West Valley Road, Suite 1700 in Wayne. Senior citizens and veterans are permitted to attend events free of charge even if they do not have a pass.

The activities and events to which this policy applies include most concerts and dramatic productions as well as home sports events during the regular season, excluding PIAA playoffs and tournaments. Complimentary admission to the annual high school musical will be limited to general admission seating if space permits.
