Food and Nutrition Services Cafeteria Point of Sale System

Highlights

- The system eliminates the need for daily cash or tickets to make cafeteria purchases
- Children receive a personal identification number (pin) that remains with them from grade K to 12.
- Each time a student enters his/her pin number, their picture and any alerts appear on the cashier's screen.
- Alerts include purchasing/restrictions and food allergy information, therefore all students must use their pin to make a purchase.
- System guarantees that students will not be overtly identified regarding economic status.
- Students may still pay by cash on a daily basis (must still enter pin) for cafeteria purchases, but we encourage parent's to pre-pay money in their child's account.
- Lines move quicker when cashiers don't have to handle cash, leaving more time for students to socialize at lunch.
- You may place account restrictions on your child's account by emailing the school kitchen manager.

- You can also make one-time payments or set-up automatic payments. A convenience fee is charged by PayPams for these two services.

How do I put money on my child's account?

- 1. Electronic transactions via the PayPams website.
- 2. On-site at the cafeteria with cash or check. Please write the students pin number on the check memo line.
- 3. Elementary School payments are turned in by the student in homeroom. Secondary School payments are submitted directly to the cafeteria.
- 4. If your children are in the same school, one check can be written. (please indicate in the memo section the children pin number and how much to put in each child's account).
