NEES PTO Artist in Residence Project:

• Amy Terlecki from the NEES PTO discussed an Artist in Residence project for the committee's consideration and approval. The artist, Barb Fox, displayed an example of the type of sculpture she would like to create and hang from the ceiling at the school. The Committee requesting some additional information stating the consideration of student safety and risk management. Mrs. Terlecki and Mrs. Fox agreed to work with the District to obtain this information and return to a future committee meeting to discuss the project.

Construction Report:

• Mr. Isaacson reviewed the report and updated the Committee on the scope of infrastructure projects for this coming summer, several which are currently out for bid.

Committee Goals:

• Mrs. Burger reviewed the revisions made at the last meeting to the 2017 Committee goals. The revised goals were approved by the Committee.

ES and MS Air Conditioning Study:

- Mr. Delp reviewed the HVAC Study report, an update to a comprehensive HVAC Study performed in 2008. He stated that the challenge to add air conditioning to these buildings is that they were all built in the 1960's, which adds to the estimated cost. Mr. Delp also stated that he does not see any real immediate solutions that are less expensive than those presented in the report. Total estimated construction cost for the ES and MS is \$12,271,650.
- The Committee asked if along with the temperature data being collected, humidity levels could be collected as well. Mr. McDonnell stated that at the direction of the Facilities Committee, the District began collecting classroom and building temperatures last fall. Although there aren't humidity monitors in all classrooms, there are monitors in the building that can be used to collect data. The Administration will work with the HVAC controls contracted services provider to collect this data.

The number below reflects the average of the five bids received for the three specified turf products, including the alternate for the "C" logo. The bids included the potential replacement of 15,000 square feet of 'E' layer if found to be necessary.

Budget Estimate Total:	\$ 640,000.
Bid Total:	\$ 444,450.
Difference - Under:	\$ 195,550.

The project documents included three manufacturers that our turf consultant thought were best and relatively equal. We allowed alternate products to be bid at contractor's options, but were not considered equal to the specified products. The unanimous choice by the staff and professionals is the Shaw, Powerblade turf system.
