

Tobacco, Smoking Products and Electronic Smoking Products: Use (General Public)

The use of tobacco by anyone is prohibited within all of the buildings owned by the District, on school grounds, in school vehicles and/or while participating in or supervising school-sponsored activities on or off school premises. The foregoing is a total ban on all tobacco use in any District building, on any District property, in any District vehicle and/or during any District-sponsored activity. Violation of this Policy will result in penalties as provided in Regulation 1330.

For the purposes of this Policy and its accompanying regulation, "the use of tobacco" shall mean all uses of tobacco, including lighted or unlighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking product or material, smokeless tobacco in any form, and electronic smoking products. "Electronic smoking products" mean electronic products designed to deliver nicotine, flavor and/or other potentially harmful chemicals or are otherwise designed to simulate use of tobacco products.
