

Teacher Participation in Evening Meetings

Teachers are encouraged to participate in evening meetings that reflect the school's educational program. The obvious value of such participation to the professional teacher, the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District, and the interested parents or guardians merits such a commitment. However, although teachers are encouraged to attend and participate in all such evening programs, a teacher is not required to attend more than two evening programs as stipulated by their principal during the school year.
