Private Coaching or Training of Students by District Athletic Coaches

No one employed as a District athletic coach ("District Coach") is permitted to receive financial remuneration for the private coaching or private training of District student-athletes who play in the same school and sport for which the District Coach is employed.

For purposes of this Policy and its accompanying regulation, the following definitions apply:

"Private Coaching" means administering, directing, or coaching a camp or clinic, league, non-District team, or tournament that is attended by players from the school sports team for which the District Coach is employed to coach, whether in-season or out-of-season.

"Private Training" means providing instruction in the techniques, skills or performance relevant to the particular sport coached by the District Coach, but outside of the coaching done on behalf of the District. This includes both in-season and out-of-season training as well as training attended by players from the school sports team for which the District Coach is employed to coach, in-season and out-of-season.
