Student Conduct on District-Provided Transportation

Students shall not engage in conduct that endangers that student's safety or the safety of others on District-provided transportation.

The driver, or other assigned personnel, is expected to handle routine behavior problems; but when misconduct continues, the problem will be referred to a school administrator using the established reporting system as soon as possible but, in any event, within one school day of the occurrence. Building administrators will assess the student conduct in question and take necessary action in accordance with Board Policy, Administrative Regulation and other District procedures. District-provided transportation is a privilege which may be withdrawn for a specified period by the building principal or designee. Recurrent misbehavior shall be addressed in consultation with the Superintendent's office.
