## Nonparticipation in Specific Instruction and State Assessments

Upon receipt of a written request from the parent or guardian of a student, or the student themselves if they are an emancipated minor (as defined in the accompanying regulation), the student shall be excused from specific instruction or required state assessments conflicting with their religious beliefs in accordance with applicable law as set forth in the accompanying regulation. For purposes of this Policy, locally approved and administered assessments established pursuant to state law regarding state assessments are to be treated as state assessments.
