

*Security of District Facilities*

The Board recognizes the need to maintain the security of District facilities and to ensure the safety of students, staff, and visitors. Further, the Board recognizes the need to protect District property against acts of vandalism, theft, and unauthorized access/entrance.

To this end, a program of building security shall be administered by the Superintendent or designee, with the cooperation of building principals and designated staff.

The Superintendent shall promulgate regulations implementing this policy that, at a minimum:

- (1) Designate individuals entitled to have keys or proximity cards to District facilities and equipment;
- (2) Identify those individuals who are authorized to enter upon District property; and
- (3) Establish procedures relating to instances of unauthorized access/entrance onto District property.
