## Drug and Alcohol Testing of Drivers

In accordance with United States Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations the District shall require drug and alcohol testing of drivers whether employed by the District or a contractor providing transportation services. If the DOT regulations are amended, the District will comply with the amended regulations automatically without the need to reissue this Policy or update the accompanying Administrative Regulation. Drug and alcohol testing will be conducted on any current or prospective driver with a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) who performs safety-sensitive functions and operates a vehicle in excess of 26,000 pounds or a vehicle designed to carry 16 passengers (including the driver).
