Complimentary Admission to Events

Guidelines and Eligibility

Policy 1125 and thus this Regulation apply only to events sponsored by Tredyffrin/Easttown School District, and only to District residents. Those who have questions about whether complimentary admission is available for a particular event are encouraged to call the office of the school where the event is to take place.

The community member stipulating senior or veteran status will not be required to present identification regarding such status but will be allowed to self-identify.

Complimentary admission to the opening night of the annual high school theater productions can be made by calling the high school main office in advance.

Publicizing the Policy

Individuals monitoring admission to school events will be notified in advance by the principal or designee of the practice of allowing senior citizens and veterans to enter without charge.

Annually the communications specialist will notify the community of the availability of complimentary admission to events according to Policy 1125 through the following means:

Periodic inclusion of a short item in the District e-newsletter

Posting of appropriate information on the District web site

Creation of an item for the TETV scroll to run each August and September

- Creation of signs to be posted at entrances to major athletic venues in the District and table signs to be used on ticket tables for plays, musicals, and other events for which complimentary admission is available
- Additional publicity as deemed appropriate by the communications specialist and the administration.
