Contests and Other Competitions for Prizes Involving Students

All requests for permission to conduct a contest either at the District level or within any school of the District, must be submitted in writing to the Superintendent at least one month prior to the requested date for holding the contest.

Written proposals must state in specific terms the purpose of the contest, the method of conducting the contest, the nature of the contest, the approximate time necessary to conduct the contest, and the planned use of the results of the contest.

The Superintendent, at their discretion, may mandate that parental permission be secured as a condition to a student entering a contest.

All proposals must include a statement to the effect that the District, or an individual school, or an individual associated in any way with the District or a school of the District will not be identified in any publication without prior permission of the individual and the Superintendent.

All contracts involving contests must be approved by the Business Office.
