

School District Communications with the Public

The ongoing support of the Tredyffrin/Easttown community is essential to achieving the goal of fostering partnerships and relationships with families, alumni, staff, school district support groups, local community groups, leaders, resources, businesses, institutions and other community members. All Board members, District employees and other representatives of the District are expected to maintain positive, cordial communications with all members of our community and the public at large.

The public shall be kept informed of actions taken at all regular and special meetings of the Board. The District shall inform the public of the actions taken at these Board meetings.

The District will communicate clearly and consistently with the public, welcome public opinion and comments, and keep the public informed about the Board, the District, and the student activities and programs through various methods of regular, periodic communications. These will include, but will not be limited to, legally required notices of public meetings and other media approved by the Board, as set forth in the accompanying Administrative Regulation.

The District values the community's input and provides a number of opportunities for residents to share their input, such as through signed correspondence addressed to the Board or administration, participation in the public comment periods at public meetings and telephone communication.
