The District is committed to facilitate the understanding and promote tolerance of cultural and individual differences; recognize, respect, and appreciate our global, national, and local diversity; make ongoing efforts to broaden the inclusive nature of the school and community; and promote inclusive curriculum at all levels.

To promote these initiatives, the District shall maintain a committee to be called the "Diversity Committee" for the purpose of providing a forum on diversity issues.

The Diversity Committee will be comprised of a diverse group of parents, teachers, students, community members, and administrators, representing a variety of backgrounds and perspectives. The administration will appoint members pursuant to administrative regulation. Additionally, the Board will appoint a Board member to participate in the Committee meetings each year. The Committee will meet publicly during the school year.
