

Building Principals

General Provisions

Under the authority of the Superintendent, each building principal shall be responsible for, and shall have authority over, the actions of students, employees, visitors and persons hired to perform special tasks. The principal shall be the leader within the school and shall be responsible for curriculum development and improvement subject to the guidance and direction of the Superintendent within the basic framework defined by the District.

Each principal shall organize the assigned school within the framework of the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District's educational policies and shall apply the elements of that program in a way most appropriate for the students attending that school.

Each principal shall keep the administrative staff and the Superintendent informed of activities in the school by whatever means the Superintendent deems appropriate.

Building principals are designated as first-level supervisors in accordance with Article III, Section 19 of Act 195, Public Employee Relations Acts.
