Public Performances and Community Services by Student Organizations

While the Board recognizes the values accruing from student participation in civic and community affairs, first consideration shall be given to the academic schedule of the individual student.

This includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Public Performances by Student Organizations whether or not on District property such as concerts, vocal, instrumental or dramatic performances; and
- 2. Community service by Student Organizations off school property whether or not occurring during the school day.
