Access to Curriculum Information

This Policy is established to comply with the requirement of the State Board of Education that school districts provide access to information about the curriculum. The Board desires to provide opportunities to review instructional materials and have access to information about curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques.

Upon request, the District will promptly make available existing information about the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques.

In accordance with Policies and Regulations 6160 *Selection of Instructional Materials* and 1122 *Complaints or Comments Regarding the District*, parents may request a District review of the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials, and assessment techniques.

Parents have the right to inspect any instructional material in the child's curriculum. Requests to review instructional materials shall be made in writing to the Director of Curriculum and shall be granted within a reasonable time from receipt of the written request. Instructional materials may be reviewed at the District administration building and in the presence of the Director of Curriculum or designee.

Parents shall have the right to have their children excused from specific instruction which conflicts with their religious beliefs, upon receipt by the School District of a written request specifically outlining the topics from which the student is to be excused.
