

Authority to Operate the District

The management, control, and operation of the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District is vested by the State Legislature in the Tredyffrin/Easttown Board of School Directors, which exercises the powers granted and discharges the duties imposed by Pennsylvania statutes. The School Directors shall be the elected representatives of the residents of the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District. It shall be the purpose of the Board to provide an educational program of a scope and quality that addresses the best interests of the residents of Tredyffrin/Easttown School District, including preeminently, the educational needs of the children. In financing this educational program, the Board shall consider the resources of the community. The Board of School Directors shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local statutes and regulations.
