## Tredyffrin/Easttown Diversity Committee

The Superintendent will appoint a member of the administration to chair the Diversity Committee and the School Board will appoint a Board member annually to serve on the committee. The committee will be comprised of a diverse group of parents, teachers, students, community members and administrators representing various religious, ethnic, cultural and community backgrounds. A balance in age and gender will also be considered. When personal circumstances prompt an individual to retire from the committee, the administration will seek to replace the departing committee member with someone of a similar background and perspective. In addition, every three years, the administration will review the composition of the entire membership to ensure that it reflects the goals of Policy 1220.
