

*Assistant Principals – Middle School and High School*

In order to permit and to encourage principals personally to supervise the instructional program in their schools, it shall be the policy of the Board to appoint assistant principals to handle scheduling, discipline, and other detail.

The duties of each assistant principal shall be outlined in detail by the principal with the approval of the Superintendent. In the absence of the principal, the assistant principal shall be responsible for, and in complete control of, the school.
