Student Performance

- 1. Each school is encouraged to sponsor a reasonable number of performance events in the nature of concerts, displays, shows, exhibitions, teas, declamatory contests, operettas or banquets.
- 2. These performances or special events shall be planned in so far as possible on an annual basis, or at least as far in advance as possible, so that the majority of such programs may appear on the District annual calendar of events.
- 3. The plans for such events must be approved by the principal of the school. Requests for approval of these events shall be submitted on a standard form to be provided to all teachers. This form shall list the name of the activity, admission charges, if any, chaperones, sponsoring group and contemplated expenditures or receipts.
- 4. If admission is charged, an anticipated budget showing expected costs and income shall be attached. The use to which any net proceeds will be put shall also be stated.
- 5. Effort shall be made, insofar as possible, to schedule such events on evenings that will not conflict with students' school work for the next day. Evening rehearsals shall be kept to a minimum and close at a reasonable hour.
