U.S. Presidential Requests to Address T/E Students

As with all programs included in the curricular day, the content of the address will be considered by a Superintendent to determine the appropriateness with the curriculum and suitability for the age of the students.

Taking into consideration the following parameters, the Superintendent or designee, where practically possible and reasonable within the confines of the curriculum, will make arrangements to show the address to the students.

Considerations:

- Time of day
- Time in the school year (standardized testing window, school in session, prior to a school break, immediately following a return from break, first week of school)
- Technological method of delivery and required support
- Context/subject of address

The District also recognizes the civic/educational benefits that accrue to students when they are provided the opportunity to hear addresses from a variety of non-presidential officeholders at the federal, Pennsylvania state level, and local level. Therefore, the Superintendent will seriously consider such requests by current officeholders on a case-by-case basis, ensuring once again the educational character of such requests, as well as the logistical and other feasibility factors that might affect the mode of delivery of such addresses.
