

HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR



STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Conestoga High School's Boys Soccer Team took home the state championship title during the fall 2016 season. The team won the Central Athletic League with an undefeated 11-0 record. The coaches of the Central League voted to give Conestoga the Sportsmanship Award for the fourth year in a row. In the State playoffs, Conestoga defeated Elizabethtown in the final game to become State Champions.
