

**T/E and Conestoga High School
Athletic Hall of Fame
Berwyn, Pennsylvania**

Selection Criteria

The following items will determine the appropriateness of a person's induction:

- 1) Categories established for selection into the Hall of Fame:
 - a) Athletes
 - b) Teams
 - c) Coaches
 - d) Contributors (Gerry Gasser Award)
- 2) In any given year, up to 7 inductees should be inducted into the T/E and Conestoga Athletic Hall of Fame. The Selection Committee may recommend to the Steering Committee that either no one or more than 7 inductees be inducted in a given year.
- 3) All nominees must have exhibited sound educational and personal values and have demonstrated high standards of integrity and character.
- 4) An athlete/team must have graduated from T/E or Conestoga High School at least ten years before being considered for selection. Accomplishments in a school-sponsored sport, which can be used as a starting point for selection include:
 - a) All-league honors
 - b) All-county honors
 - c) All-state honors
 - d) All-American
 - e) Team's most valuable players
 - f) Athlete-of-the-year honorees
 - g) Record holders
 - h) State champions/Titles
 - i) Success at the college, professional, national, or international level
- 5) Coaches can be considered for their success such as win-loss records and league titles won. Additional consideration can include motivational and personal success. Nominated coaches must be retired from the T/E School District.
- 6) A contributor can be an outstanding athletic director, an administrator who went the extra mile for athletics, or a person from within the school or community who showed outstanding service over a significant period of time.
- 7) Nominations may be received from anyone other than a relative of the person being nominated. Upon nomination, nominees will be contacted to supply profile information.
- 8) After nomination and sufficient discussion of each athlete nominated for the class, approval of a majority of the Selection Committee members present is necessary for induction. Selection Committee members must be present in order to cast a vote.
- 9) A running list of nominees shall be kept on file with supportive data for each person nominated. The Selection Committee will discuss each name and vote on the presented individuals.
- 10) Selection Committee decisions are final and not subject to appeal.
