The district will be sending home separate directions on where to access this information. Here are a few additional pieces of information that we would like to share.

- 1. We respect that you may also be working from home during this time. Please know that while we are providing assignments and making specific suggestions, we know that you may need to alter these expectations in order to meet your family's needs in your home during this time. Feel free to email us with any concerns or questions you may have as they arise.
- 2. We also know that different families have various technology tools in the home. We have tried to provide you with an array of activities that include both paper/pencil and technology resources. Please choose activities that best suit the needs of your families at this time. In some cases, you may have alternate activities that you would like to substitute (like baking, math games, puzzles, etc.)
- 3. We are not expecting you to teach new skills in your home. These packets are designed to help your child practice skills they have already learned. When we return to school, we will pick up where we left off.
- 4. How, when and what work gets submitted is between you and your child.
- 5. As always, we will help in any way possible. Feel free to drop us an email If we cant answer your questions, perhaps we can point you in the right direction. We appreciate your patience as we navigate a new period.
