Math Study for Acceleration Process

- Student or parent expresses interest in math acceleration
- Student/parent should contact Dr. Nancy Adams, Curriculum Supervisor via email or phone at <u>adamsn@tesd.net</u> or 610-240-1907 by the last school day in any given school year.
- Student must sign course selection card for the course they will take next year if they DO NOT accelerate.
- Student must do one of the following:
 - 1. Participate in a summer course at parent's expense
 - 2. Participate in 30 hours of private tutoring + 30 hours of home study at parent's expense
- At the end of either option, the student must come to the District Office and take our District exam and score an 85% or better. We will provide a link for signing up for a test session, once you email us that your child is ready. There are a limited number of times available.
- If the student does all of the above and scores an 85% or better, the student's counselor and/or principal will be notified and a schedule change will be made.
- Students are to complete the test as soon as possible or by August 15th
- Students must document their summer math study and bring it with them to the test taking session.
- Students can take an assessment only **one** time.
- No students shall "skip" a course without following this practice.
- Students may only accelerate through one course in any given summer.
