In addition, your child's Tredyffrin/Easttown Elementary School Progress Report for the academic year 2021-2022 will be sent to you through the PowerSchool parent portal on Friday, November 19. (https://powerschool.tesd.net/public). Once logged in to PowerSchool, you will see a "Standards Based Report Card" link in the navigation menu on the left side of the page. Once you click on the progress report link, choose M1 to view your child's first marking period progress report for the 2021-22 school year. In the special areas (library, art, music, and physical education) section of the progress report, please be aware that special area teachers provide progress information for kindergarten during the second and third marking periods. Shading is used in the first marking period grading area to show that the first marking period is ungraded for kindergarten.
