TESD is currently planning for 5 days/week of in-person instruction for the 2021-2022 school year. At the middle and high school levels, this would include a return to the traditional 8-period bell schedule that has been used in prior years. Additionally, the District is exploring an all virtual option for families who may have an interest in an alternative to in-person instruction.

- This virtual instructional option would be a stand alone program that would be dedicated to TESD virtual students only. It would not be integrated with the inperson instructional model.
- Students who opt to participate in the TESD virtual program would be taught by District teachers using the TESD curriculum.
- Virtual students would have the opportunity to participate in TESD extracurricular activities and schoolwide events in-person.
- Enrollment in the virtual instructional option would be a full year commitment.

While details about the virtual program are still being developed, we would like to collect feedback from TESD families in order to determine whether enough interest exists to pursue a virtual instructional option. This survey is an initial assessment of interest and is not a commitment to an instructional model. It is our hope that all TESD families will complete the interest survey regardless of their instructional model preference. The interest survey will be open through Wednesday, April 28, 2021.
