Through our partnership with CHOP and the Chester County Health Department (CCHD) we are able to offer this assurance testing at no cost to you or your student. This assurance testing is strictly voluntary. More information about the tests is available on the CCHD website.

The survey will be open through Friday, September 10, 2021. Once we know the number of students participating in the antigen testing, we will develop a plan and contact you with details specific to your child.
