# Masking

- No change at this time
- CDC continues to recommend masking while indoors for schools
- CCHD continues to recommend that the District follow the guidance of the CDC

# Contact tracing & quarantine

- CCHD no longer authorizes the District to conduct contact tracing and issue a quarantine letter on the County's behalf
- If a person tests positive contact your child's school nurse and attendance office
- District will continue to update the dashboard
- Positive cases should contact their healthcare provider and refer to the CCHD website
- Persons informed that they are a close contact should refer to the CCHD website

# Antigen testing

At direction of CCHD we will conduct tests for two groups:

- Symptomatic students and staff
- Students and staff on Day 5 of self-directed quarantine (not a requirement to return to school)

# Vaccine progress and partnership

- Anyone aged 5 and up is eligible for a vaccine
- Anyone aged 12 and up is eligible for a booster
- Continue to partner with Springfield Pharmacy

# Other

## School events

- Spectator capacity at events may be adjusted to reflect transmission rates

## Public meetings

- Will aim to have as much physical distancing as possible
