

Program Goal

Provide a fully virtual option for families who are not comfortable sending their child to

school for in-person instruction during the 21-22 school year



Program Overview

- Full-time K-12 virtual program with the added services that Tredyffrin/Easttown School District has to offer
- Multiple online platforms with over 400 courses (including honors, Advanced Placement and NCAA-approved courses)
- Your child remains a TESD student
- A seat for each student will be held in their grade level within TESD
- Course content and sequence will align with TESD courses to the greatest extent possible
- TESD coordinates support services, including but limited to IEP, GIEP, 504, ELD, Reading/Math Support
- High school courses will count toward TESD graduation requirements but not count toward cumulative GPA
- Tredyffrin/Easttown School District diploma for students who complete graduation requirements



Program Overview (cont'd)

- State standardized testing taken in TESD
- District-provided device for all students
- Coordinated days off with TESD calendar
- Ability to participate in school clubs, events, activities, music groups, athletics
- Continue to receive communications re: TESD school events
- Commitment through at least one marking period
