



VFMS Grade 6 Supply List for 2024-25



Required Summer Reading: see the [VFMS library web](#) page for details.

- 1 **Supply case** zippered with three holes (no boxes)
 - 2-3 Boxes of **pencils** with at least 4 in supply case (Remaining pencils at home. Replenish as needed.)
 - 1 Hand-held manual pencil **sharpener**
 - 1 Large **eraser**
 - Highlighters** (at least two different colors)
 - 3 Sharpies (2 ultra fine point black and 1 standard fine point)
 - At least 1 **Glue stick**
 - 1 Pack of **colored pencils** (12 colors)
- 3 Packs of 3x3 **Post-It Notes**
- At least 1 Pack of **Index cards** (3x5, white, 100 per pack)

Binders

- 6th Grade **Gold Team**: 2 Binders (1.5 inch)
- 6th Grade **Blue Team**: 1 Binder (1.5 inch) or Accordion-type organizer that has a minimum of 6 sections.
- 6 **Folders** (Three-hole punched. One for each core class and one extra for special areas.)
- 3 **Composition** marble notebooks. Note: Not a spiral.
- 1 Pack of three-hole punched lined loose-leaf **paper** (100 Sheets with 10-20 in binder. Remaining sheets for home.)

If enrolled in *Math 6, Math 7 or Pre-Algebra*

- TI-15 or TI-30 **calculator**

If enrolled in *Algebra I*

- TI-84 **calculator** or higher
- Graph paper** notebook
- 1 Pair of wired **head-phones** that connect to laptop.
- 2 Boxes of **tissues** (give to homeroom teacher on first day)
- Optional: 1 Container of sanitizing **wipes** (give to homeroom teacher on first day)

- Keep supply list receipts as certain supplies could be adjusted depending on teacher and courses students are enrolled in.
