Ms. Dawn Settle and her students from Valley Forge Middle School shared their experience attending the Middle School Leadership Summit at the University of Pennsylvania's Consortium for Excellence and Equity. Ms. Settle shared an overview of the day along with the teacher sessions she attended. The students shared information about the student leadership sessions on Code Switching and Brainstem. The students also shared how they are using their training from the summit at Valley Forge Middle Schools as leaders in school clubs.

T/E Middle School Principal Mr. Andy Phillips along with Señor Carvajal and students from the school's Multi-Cultural Club shared activities that have been implemented this year as part of their Cultural Proficiency initiative. Students shared how they have been developing opportunities and HERO (Honesty, Empathy, Respect, Open-mindedness) lessons with teachers in order to provide students with discussion topics on inclusion and understanding of cultures. Mr. Phillips shared how teachers are developing their own cultural proficiency through discussion at teacher meetings. Ms. Jen Marsala, PTO parent, shared the work the PTO is doing to include and welcome new families to the school.
