Levels

♦ Honors - taught at high school level, but like AP courses, provide the greatest challenge and best preparation for success at academically rigorous colleges.

♦ <u>Advanced Placement</u> college-level courses taught according to syllabi prescribed by The College Board Advanced Placement Program. Possible college credit can be awarded by the college through AP tests.


