

## JUNIOR YEAR CHECKLIST 2022-23

## FALL / FIRST SEMESTER

- □ Begin talking with parents/guardians/advisors about post-high school plans.
- □ If you took the October PSAT, results are available in December. Use the *Access Code* provided on your score report to link to FREE individualized SAT test prep through Khan Academy.
- □ Register for standardized testing (SAT, ACT, AP, TOEFL, DuoLingo, etc.).

- □ Attend College Fairs and sign up for Fall College Visits on SCOIR.
- □ Prospective athletes should register with the NCAA Eligibility Center. <u>https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/</u>
- □ Attend appointment with counselor about post-high school planning.
- □ Use SCOIR and other resources for college and career research and information.
- □ Plan college visits when you are ready.

## WINTER & SPRING/ SECOND SEMESTER

- □ Make an appointment with your counselor for a Junior Planning Conference with parent/guardians (conferences open on **November 28<sup>th</sup>**).
- □ Continue college and career searches using SCOIR and other resources.
- □ Attend Financial Aid Evening on March 9<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm (virtual).
- □ Attend Career Days/Military Day sessions in March.
- □ Attend college fairs and begin visiting colleges. Be sure to schedule a tour through the university admissions office whenever possible by registering on the college's admissions page.
- □ Prospective athletes should attend the NCAA Presentation on May 11<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm (virtual).
- Begin writing your college essays (May).
- □ Speak with 2 junior year teachers to request college letters of recommendation starting around mid-March.
  - You should have your recommenders secured before the last day of school!
  - After you receive a verbal agreement from your teacher, you MUST request your recommendations in SCOIR under *My Colleges* → *Application Documents* → *Request a Recommendation* → *Search your teacher* → *Select and hit send*
- □ Complete your Junior Questionnaire under Surveys in SCOIR **DUE JUNE 1**<sup>st</sup>.
- □ Create a Common Application account at <u>https://www.commonapp.org/</u>.

## SUMMER

- □ Continue to visit college campuses. Take pictures and notes. SCOIR allows you to save notes on the app.
- □ Work on your college essay.
- $\hfill\square$  Common Application opens for application submissions on AUGUST 1<sup>st</sup>.
- □ Sign your Conestoga Transcript Release/Recommendation Waiver (included in summer mailing).
- □ If you are planning on additional testing in senior year (SAT, ACT), sign up for an Aug/Sept/Oct test date.
- □ Update SCOIR move colleges from *Following*  $\rightarrow$  *Applying*.
