

# Summer Math Study Process

What type of preparation is required?

- Student must do ONE of the following to prepare:
  1. Participate in a summer course at parent's expense\*
    - a. The course may be online or in person
    - b. Proof of completion will be requiredOR
  2. Participate in 30 hours of private tutoring + 30 hours of home study at parent's expense\*
    - a. Private tutors must have a background in math and have prior teaching or tutoring experience
    - b. Proof of hours will be required

How and when will the Assessment be given?

- The District assessment will be offered on the following dates and times:
  - Thursday, August 4, 2022, 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM
  - Thursday, August 4, 2022, 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM
  - Friday, August 5, 2022, 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM
  - Friday, August 5, 2022 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM
- The assessments will be given in an In-Person format only.

How do I sign my child up?

- Contact Erin Robert ([roberte@tesd.net](mailto:roberte@tesd.net)) to indicate that your child will be going through the Summer Math Study process by June 15, 2022.

What are the requirements for successful completion?

- Students must document their summer math study and bring it with them to the assessment, AND
- Students must take our District exam and score an 85% or better.

What is other information I need to know?

- Student must sign the course selection card for the course they will take next year if they DO NOT accelerate.
- Students can take an assessment only **one** time.
- No students shall “skip” a course without following this practice.
- Students may only accelerate through one course in any given summer.
- Courses do not count for credit and will not appear on a transcript.
