Because effective learning is best done on a full stomach, T&E Care supports families in the T/E School District who meet certain income criteria with a school meal assistance program. Families who are approved for free or reduced lunch assistance are <u>not</u> eligible to apply for our program as well. If your family could use a little extra help with breakfast and/or lunch assistance and you feel you might fit the criteria explained in the application, please contact your child's counselor for a copy of the application. You can also go to T&E Care's website to download the application (address below). There is no deadline to apply – your child can join this program at any time during the school year. Assuming funds permit, the assistance of \$30/mo/student for elementary students, \$40/mo/student for middle school students, and \$50/mo/student for CHS students will be offered by T&E Care in the 2016/2017 school year.
