## SCHOOL MEAL SUPPLEMENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM 2020/2021

Dear Parent/Guardian,

T&E Care recognizes that school meals can be difficult for some families to afford on a regular basis. We have a program that can provide a limited subsidy for these expenses for qualifying students. **This program will provide a minimum of \$35/month for each student during the school year.** 

<u>Who will qualify?</u> You <u>must FIRST have applied for and been denied</u> participation in the free/reduced program run through the school district before applying for this program. Students will be eligible based on household income. The T&E Care program is set to be a transition for families making <u>just</u> "too much money" to qualify for free/reduced assistance. See income guidelines on application.

<u>How do I apply</u>? You must complete the attached confidential application and give it to a counselor.

<u>Is there a deadline</u>? Applications can be submitted anytime during the school year (after August 20).

<u>How is income confirmed</u>? The head of the household must certify with a signature that he/she is in compliance with the income guidelines described on the application. If you need an exception to these criteria – please contact us at lunchhelp@tecare.org.

<u>How will my child(ren) receive the benefit?</u> A minimum of \$35 will be deposited into each eligible child's point-of-sale account. These deposits will be made during the first week of each month.

<u>Could the monthly benefit be more than \$35</u>? The plan for the 2020/2021 year is that the elementary students will get \$35/month, middle school students will get \$45/month, and CHS students will get \$55/month. (An exception is made in June when less than the full amount may be paid.)

<u>Will my child get the money each month</u>? If your child does not use the funds over a few months and a positive balance starts to build up, then the funds will not be added until we see that the child is back to buying meals again.

<u>What is the source of funding for this program</u>? Most of the funding comes from donations from community members who recognize the importance of healthy meals for all children.

<u>Can the money be used for breakfast or lunch</u>? The money is put into your child's account to use as he/she wishes.

<u>Where should the application be submitted?</u> Applications should be given to your child's counselor, who will notify you if your application is approved. If you have more than one child (and/or more than one counselor) – just choose any one of the counselors. (One application per household.)

<u>Why must I first apply to the free/reduced school program before applying for the T&E Care program?</u> If you qualify for the free/reduced program, it offers better assistance for your child's meals, <u>plus</u> additional options for assistance for your child at school (dental assistance, field trip waivers, test application waivers, etc.). If you can qualify for that program – it is better for your child(ren).

<u>Who will know that my child is getting this assistance?</u> The food service department will know, your child's counselor and principal may know, and a couple of T&E Care folks will know. That's it, unless you tell people. We totally understand the need for privacy in this type of request.
