

TESD Pandemic Plan COVID-19

Responses will be determined with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), PA Department of Health, and Chester County Health Department

Monitoring

Schools operating normally

Monitor presence of COVID-19 locally and regionally

Provide preventative education campaign, e.g. proper handwashing technique

Review Pandemic Action Plan

Travelers (students and staff) to CDC designated Level 3 areas are required to stay at home for 14 days after returning to the United States

Monitor areas with confirmed cases in relation to students travelling to our District

Custodial staff continues to disinfect surfaces daily with cyclical deep cleaning for added sanitization

Limiting & Postponing

Schools open or isolated short-term school closures for deep cleaning

Consider rescheduling or canceling student and staff District-sponsored travel to areas with confirmed cases

Consider limiting audience attendance at District-sponsored events, athletic contests, and extra-curricular activities

Consider rescheduling or canceling outside group facility use in our buildings

Consider rescheduling or canceling student volunteer activities that are outside of the schools

Consider rescheduling or canceling all student and staff District-sponsored travel

Consider rescheduling or canceling District-sponsored events, athletic contests, and extra-curricular activities

Consider rescheduling or canceling programs that bring in outside presenters and volunteers to the District

Consider freezing student participation in out of district academic programs

Closing

Extended school closure

Suspend all campus activities

Work with local and state health agencies to determine length of closure

Freeze all District-sponsored travel

Monitor guidance from PDE and Secretary of Education regarding any changes to state standardized testing, school calendar requirements and implementation of electronic learning as permitted

Coordinate with health authorities for guidance on using school facilities as dispensing centers or shelters

Communicate with the school community as needed based on frequency and proximity of cases
