## Directions and Routes to the CCIU Education Services Center:

### From the North

- Follow Route 100 south to business Route 30 - Lincoln Highway (Exton)
- Turn right onto Route 30 west
- Follow Route 30 west to Quarry Road
- Turn left onto Quarry Road
- Follow for approximately 1/2 mile to the third traffic light (Boot Road)
- Turn right onto Boot Road
- Follow approximately 1/4 mile to 455 Boot Road (on the right after the Dopaco building).

**Note:** If you pass the entrance, please continue on Boot Road and make the next right onto CCIU Drive at the traffic light.

### From the South

- Follow Route 100 north to the Route 30/100 intersection and turn left at light onto business Route 30 west
- Follow Route 30 west to Quarry Road and turn left
- Follow for approximately 1/2 mile to the third traffic light (Boot Road)
- Turn right onto Boot Road
- Follow Boot Road for approximately 1/4 mile to 455 Boot Road (on the right after the Dopaco building).

**Note:** If you pass the entrance, please continue on Boot Road and make the next right onto CCIU Drive at the traffic light.

### From the West

- From Route 30 bypass, exit at business Route 30/Lancaster Avenue
- At the traffic light at the bottom of the ramp turn left onto Quarry Road
- Follow Quarry Road for approximately 1/4 mile to the first traffic light (Boot Road)
- Turn right onto Boot Road
- Follow for approximately 1/4 mile to 455 Boot Road (on the right after the Dopaco building).

**Note:** If you pass the entrance, please continue on Boot Road and make the next right onto CCIU Drive at the traffic light.

### From the East

- From Route 202 south, exit at the US 202/30 interchange onto the Route 30 west bypass
- Take the Business Route 30/Route 30 exit to business Route 30 west
- At the traffic light at the bottom of the ramp turn left onto Route 30 west
- Follow business Route 30 west to Quarry Road and turn left onto Quarry Road
- Follow Quarry Road for approximately 1/2 mile to the third traffic light (Boot Road)
- Turn right onto Boot Road.
- Follow for approximately 1/4 mile to 455 Boot Road (on the right after the Dopaco building).

**Note:** If you pass the entrance, please continue on Boot Road and make the next right onto CCIU Drive at the traffic light.
