News from the Nurse About Sunscreen

The PA Dept. of Health has passed a sun protection measure stating that students can self-apply non-aerosolized FDA approved sunscreen as needed. News from the Nurse...

ANYTIME a doctor's note is written to excuse a student from gym class for an extended period of time (2 or more gym classes), a clearance note **MUST** be provided from the doctor once the student is deemed well enough to resume physical activities. Some examples of when a clearance note is required include after having a cast, sprain requiring crutches, concussion, or any other injury. A student cannot resume gym until a doctor's clearance note is received. This is a Pennsylvania state requirement.

Student Drop-Off by Parents- Safety First!

Parents who drive their children to school are reminded to **PLEASE** form a **SINGLE** car line for student drop-off in the morning. While morning can be a hectic time for everyone, forming two lines creates a dangerous situation where students need to cut in front of other cars to enter the school. Whether dropping off students at the main entrance or the Old Lancaster Road entrance, please merge into a single line so your students can exit your vehicle at the curb. We thank you for your patience and understanding, and appreciate everyone's commitment to maintaining a safe situation for all students. At no time should vehicles other than school buses use the bus circle.

ATTENDANCE, ABSENCES, TARDINESS

Students are required to be in regular attendance at school unless detained by illness or other urgent reasons.

- Parents should email the attendance office at temattendance@tesd.net to report a child's absence by 8:45 am on the morning that he/she will be absent.
- If unable to email an excuse note, a written excuse note signed by the parent or legal guardian should be submitted to the main office before school on the morning after the absence.
- Parents can submit up to 10 excuse notes for illness in one school year. Any absences beyond 10 must be excused by a doctor or medical professional.
- If after three days no email or written excuse note is received, the absence will be marked as unexcused.
- Absences are registered as excused for only those reasons cited in the PA School Code: personal illness, health care, death in the family, approved travel, religious holiday, and religious study. If a student is absent for any other reason, the absence will be recorded as “unexcused.”
- Upon returning to school, students should report to teachers and find out what work has been missed.
- In order to participate in interscholastic sporting events, a student must be in attendance by 10:30 am on the day of the event.
