Students Entering 7th Grade

The Pennsylvania Department of Health School Health law requires **ALL** students entering 7th grade to have the following **PRIOR** to the first day of school:

- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE

Additionally, the Pennsylvania School Act requires that all students in grade 7 receive a dental examination. This examination should be returned to the school at the beginning of the school year. Dental examinations should be scheduled with your family dentist ASAP. Advanced notice is being provided to enable you to schedule the exam over the summer break.

Students who are interested in playing sports for TEMS next year are reminded that paperwork must be completed before you may participate. The paperwork includes a physical examination by a physician after June 1, 2019. The necessary paperwork is available on the TEMS website or in the main office.

Medications

Williamsburg Medications– if you sent medication in for your child for the trip & have not picked it up at school, please do so before the last day of school, June 13. All medication must be picked up by an adult. Any medications remaining after June 14th will be discarded as per school district policy.

End of the Year Medication Pickup– all medications in the nurse’s office must be picked up by Thursday, June 13, 2019 or it will be discarded per the TESD policy. No medications can be stored in the nurse’s office over the summer. Students who have self-carry forms on file in the health room may pick up epinephrine auto-injectors or inhalers ONLY.

All other medications must be picked up by an adult as per TESD policy.

Students Entering Grade 6

The Pennsylvania School Act requires that **ALL** students in grade 6 receive a physical examination. This examination should be returned to the school nurse at the beginning of the school year. Physical exams should be scheduled with your family physician and turned in to the school nurse as soon as they are completed. Advance notice is being provided in order for you to schedule appointments over the summer break.

ATTENDANCE, ABSENCES, TARDINESS

Students are required to be in regular attendance at school unless detained by illness or other urgent reasons.

- Parents should email the attendance office at temattendance@tesd.net to report a child’s absence by 8:45 am on the morning that he/she will be absent.
- If unable to email an excuse note, a written excuse note signed by the parent or legal guardian should be submitted to the main office before school on the morning after the absence.
- Parents can submit up to 10 excuse notes for illness in one school year. Any absences beyond 10 must be excused by a doctor or medical professional.
- If after three days no email or written excuse note is received, the absence will be marked as unexcused.
- Absences are registered as excused for only those reasons cited in the PA School Code: personal illness, health care, death in the family, approved travel, religious holiday, and religious study. If a student is absent for any other reason, the absence will be recorded as “unexcused.”
- Upon returning to school, students should report to teachers and find out what work has been missed.
- In order to participate in interscholastic sporting events, a student must be in attendance by 10:30 am on the day of the event.
