#### **Committee Discussion and Recommendations:**

The Committee discussed the **Proposed Revisions to State Graduation Requirements.** They reviewed the existing Keystone Paths to Proficiency based upon the current PDE regulations. The Committee discussed four options proposed by PDE as a way to modify the current regulation. Option 1 requires students to achieve either a composite score on Keystone Exams or meet a condition established by a decision-matrix. Option 2 requires students to achieve passing scores on an alternate assessment in the three content areas of Math, ELA and Science. Option 3 allows for students participating in career and technical education to use course grades and assessments along with NOCTI or NIMS skills assessments or certificates. Option 4 allows students to demonstrate competency in the required subject matter content through course grades or assessments plus three pieces of additional evidence determined by the local district and approved by PDE.

The Committee discussed and revised the TESD Resolution regarding Pathways to Graduation. The revised resolution will be discussed at the September 26 Board meeting.

The Committee was informed of the slate of candidates for the PSBA office election.
