Phase 1 – due by the May Board meeting

- 2. Identifying considerations and the pros and cons of each alternative, including but not limited to redistricting
- The committee shall establish parameters for any potential action such as redistricting, including legal requirements, best practices, costs and other considerations adopted by the committee.
- The committee shall determine how the work should be performed, how the proposals will be developed and who will be involved in the process.

Phase 2 - due by the January Board meeting

• Committee to provide two or three detailed proposals for board discussion and action.
