Technology Cost-Sharing Fee Information

Consistent with a goal in the District Strategic Plan to "harness the power of technology to advance learning while engaging and empowering students in a connected world," the T/E School District's 1:1 Technology Initiative will provide devices to all students in grades K-12 for their use in school and at home. Families are asked to pay an annual cost-sharing fee of \$15 per student in grades K-4 and \$50 per student in grades 5-12, with a maximum annual family fee of \$100. For example, if you have one child in grades 5-12, the fee for your family is \$50. If you have two or more children in grades 5-12, the fee for your family is \$100. This fee covers Accidental Damage Protection as well as a case and set-up/maintenance of the device.

This fee may be paid online, in person or by mail.

To pay the fee online:

- 1. Visit <u>www.officialpayments.com</u>.
- 2. Click "Local Payments."
- 3. Type 4841 in the Jurisdiction Code field and press enter or enter state and payment entity.
- 4. Select "Computer Fee" from the Payment Type drop down menu and click "Make a Payment."
- 5. Enter the student's name and ID#.
- 6. Enter a \$15 amount for each child in grades K-4 and/or a \$50 amount for each child in grades 5-12, up to the maximum amount of \$100 per family. Then select the payment type and click "Continue."
- 7. Follow the on-screen instructions to create an account and make a payment.

Please note that the service provider charges a convenience fee.

To pay the fee by mail:

- Make a check payable to the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District in the amount of \$15 for each child in grades K-4 and/or \$50 for each child in grades 5-12, up to the maximum amount of \$100 per family.
- 2. Write the name(s) of the children on the memo line of the check.
- 3. Mail the check to the following address:
