Homework and Organization

The Hillside P.T.O. provides your child's first folder. If the folder is damaged or lost, a new one may be purchased at the school store.

One side of the folder will be used for homework assignments and the other side for completed and checked work and parent notices. Please ask to see the folder each day and remove notices and papers that have been checked. We request that a parent or guardian sign each homework assignment. This lets us know that you have seen the homework and that it was done at home.

We feel that the use of this Homework Folder will promote better study skills, reduce or eliminate confusion regarding assignments, and encourage positive attitudes for learning.

All grade levels have a snack break during the school day. For children in K-1, snacks are provided from home.
