Six-day Cycle Schedule:

Special area classes rotate on a six-day cycle.

Special area classes include: art, music, physical education, and library.

Absences/Changes in Dismissal:

Always remember to send a note or call the Main Office if there is a change to your child's normal dismissal routine. Please do NOT send emails to the classroom teacher regarding a change to dismissal that is to occur on the same day.

Call the school or send an email to NESattendance@tesd.net to report your child absent. If not, the attendance secretary will call to verify the absence.

Absentee notes or a completed Absent Card must be returned within 3 days of an absence. An email is also acceptable. The District will send an automated email request for a written excuse note if we indicate in our school database that a note was not received. Responding to the automated email will satisfy the requirement.

A 'Request for Excused Absence from School for Student Travel' form must be completed when your family will be traveling, causing your child to be absent from school. These forms may be obtained from the Main Office or printed from the District/school website.

Pick-up and Drop-off:

Bus Dismissal is from classrooms for Grades K-4. Bus Pick-up is at the front of the building.

Carpool Pick-up and Drop-off is at the loop by the upper parking lot. If using the Carpool Pick-up, you will receive a card with your child's last name printed on the front. Please place this card on your dashboard so staff members can quickly retrieve your child. Carpool Pick-up students will be called to their parent's vehicle from the Large Group Room.

Allergy Policy: We do not celebrate birthdays, school parties, or grade-level events with food. Students may not consume peanut or tree nut products as snacks in their classrooms.
