Assuming that approval for alternate testing is given, the examination or an alternate exam will be administered to the student at a later date. No examination will be administered prior to the scheduled examination days.

In the News from Student Health Services

As colder weather approaches, influenza or flu season will soon be upon us. Influenza can be a serious disease that leads to hospitalization or extreme illness. Reminder to 11th Grade Parents/Guardians From the Health Office

The Pennsylvania School Act requires that all students in 11th grade receive a medical examination. Please include an updated immunization record with your physical exam. Effective 8/1/17 all students entering 12th grade will be required to have **2** doses of **MCV** (Meningitis), one which needs to be at/after age 16.

Please check with your health care provider at the time of your physical examination.

ARCH To Host Youth Mental Health First Aid Training For Parents

ARCH is offering Youth Mental Health First Aid Training for parents, an 8-hour program designed to teach skills to help a young person who is struggling with a mental health concern or crisis, Wednesday, February 5th and Wednesday, February 12th, 5:00-9:00 pm at the T/E District Offices.
