## KINDERGARTEN SUPPLIES

### Each child will need:

- 1 backpack to be brought daily. Clearly label child's name inside the bag.
- Earphones (Over-the-head type) in a zip-lock bag marked with child's name.

### The following items will be shared in table caddies and used in the classroom:

- 12-15 glue sticks (small) or 10 (large) (*white*, not purple, please.)
- 1 box of 8 count Crayola washable thick markers
- 10-12 No. 2 pencils, SHARPENED
- 1 box of 24 count *Crayola* crayon
- 1 pair of *Fiskar's* youth scissors
- 2 boxes of full-size tissues
- 2 bottles of hand soap
- 2 Clorox or Wet-Ones wipes
- All: 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags
- Boys: 1 box quart size baggies
- Girls: 1 box sandwich size baggies

## FIRST GRADE SUPPLIES

- 2 dozen pencils, sharpened

- 1 large Pink eraser

- Small sharp pointed children's scissors (Fiskars brand)

- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 pack of markers
- 1 small sharp pointed scissors (Fiskars brand is good)
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 container anti-bacterial wipes
- 1 Elmer's White Glue – 4 oz
- 6 large glue sticks – white only
- 2 yellow highlighting markers
- 1 marble composition book (wide ruled)
- 1 pack of 3 post-it notes (3x3 size, light colors)
- 2 black Sharpies – fine tip
- 1 pack of 4 Expo markers
- 1 3-ring binder (1 ½") Hardcover with plastic sleeve on front
- 1 Supply box similar to the picture below. A handle on top is most helpful to the child.
